

## SpooferMail User Guide



### Important:

The application will only run if the following files are present in the same folder and in the correct format, otherwise an error message will appear and the program will close:

- spoofer.exe - The program executable
- spoofer.spa - Encrypted banner image
- spoofer.spb - Encrypted ini file
- DotNetOpenMail.dll – Mail component to avoid reliance upon MAPI through client default email application.

You **MUST** have version 2, or above, of the .Net Framework installed. If you do not have this installed the program may not work at all. I have included .net 2.0 with this program just in case you need it. To install .net 2.0 double click on the file named dotnetfx.exe.




To use Spoofermail follow these instructions:

To get it started first of all double click on **spoofer.exe** this will start SpooferMail and you can begin to enter the required information.

If you have downloaded the trial version you will see the nag screen below and also a message will be added to every email with our program name and website link. To remove both of these simply purchase the full version and all restrictions will be taken off.

**Important:** If your smtp server needs authentication you will have to enter your email address AND the password you use for this email address. See pic below for example.
